About

This indicator is the percentage of students in grades 4 and 5 who have a high level of school connectedness. Students are given a "total connectedness score" based on their responses to 5 individual questions, and a cutoff is used to identify students with a high level of school connectedness.

Calculations

This indicator is calculated by dividing the number of respondents who have a total connectedness score higher than a specified cutoff by the number of respondents who described their feelings and ideas for at least 3 of the following 5 questionnaire items: "I feel close to people at my school", "I feel I am part of my school", "I am happy to be at my school", "I feel the teachers at my school treat me fairly", and "I feel safe in my school". The response options for these 5 items are "not like me", "a little like me" and "a lot like me".

Notes

The 2019-2020 edition of this survey was conducted during the COVID-19 pandemic. Since the number of schools that participated is much lower than other editions of the survey, results at the provincial level were deemed not representative of the total student population. Therefore, survey results for New Brunswick, health zones and demographic groups are not available for the 2019-2020 edition. However, results are available for communities in which the number of participating schools was deemed sufficient to be representative of the student population in that community.
