## Calculations

This indicator is calculated by dividing the number of respondents who have a total oppositional behaviour score higher than a specified cutoff by the number of respondents who described their feelings and ideas for at least 4 of the following 7 questionnaire items: I cut classes or skip school, I make other people do what I want, I disobey my parents, I talk back to my teachers, I get into fights, I often say mean things to people to get what I want and I take things that are not mine from home, school or elsewhere. The response options for these 7 items are: 1. definitely not like me, 2., 3., 4., 5. and 6. definitely like me.

## Notes

Users are advised to exercise caution if comparing data from the community of Grand Bay-Westfield, Westfield, Greenwich Area to other New Brunswick communities. The data for the community of Grand Bay-Westfield, Westfield, Greenwich Area is based on students in grades 6 to 8, while data from the other communities are based on students in grades 6 to 12. Survey results are assigned to communities based on the location of the school. The community of Grand Bay-Westfield, Westfield, Greenwich Area does not have any schools with grades 9 to 12.
