## Calculations

This indicator is calculated by dividing the number of respondents who answered "actively (e.g. walk, bike, skateboard) and mixed (actively and inactively)" by the number of respondents who answered "actively (e.g. walk, bike, skateboard), inactively (e.g. car, bus, public transit) or mixed (actively and inactively)" to the question: How do you usually get to and from school?

## Notes
