## Calculations

This indicator is calculated by dividing the number of respondents who answered "yes" by the number of respondents who answered "yes or no". This indicator is based on respondents who answered at least 1 of the following 5 questions about volunteer activities outside of school: In the last 12 months, did you take part in any of the following volunteer activities (outside of school requirements and without being paid)? Supporting a cause (e.g. food bank, UNICEF, Operation Christmas Child), fund raising (e.g. charity, school trips), helping in my community (e.g. coaching sports, helping at Sunday School, volunteering at hospital), helping neighbours or relatives (e.g. cutting grass, babysitting, shovelling snow) and doing other organized volunteer activity.

## Notes

Users are advised to exercise caution if comparing data from the community of Grand Bay-Westfield, Westfield, Greenwich Area to other New Brunswick communities. The data for the community of Grand Bay-Westfield, Westfield, Greenwich Area is based on students in grades 6 to 8, while data from the other communities are based on students in grades 6 to 12.
