## Calculations

This indicator is based on respondents who are immigrants. This indicator is calculated by dividing the number of respondents who answered "1 to 2 years or 3 to 5 years," by the number of respondents who answered "1 to 2 years, 3 to 5 years, 6 to 10 years or 11 or more years" to the question: How long have you lived in Canada?

## Notes
