This indicator is calculated by dividing the number of respondents who answered "an other language(s)" by the number of respondents who answered "English, French, equally both French and English, Mi'kmaw, Wolastoqey or an other language(s)" to the question: What language do you speak at home most or all of the time?

### **Notes**
