This indicator is based on respondents who prefer English or French . This indicator is calculated by dividing the number of respondents who answered "French" by the number of respondents who answered "English or French" to the question: You have the right to be served in either English or French. Of these two languages, which is your preference?

## Notes

The 2021 edition of the Home Care Survey was conducted during the COVID-19 pandemic. While the pandemic did not influence the survey's response rate, users are advised to use the survey data with caution, especially when creating estimates for small sub-populations or when comparing it to other editions of the survey.
