## About

## Calculations

This indicator is based on respondents who have been bullied. This indicator is calculated by dividing the number of respondents who answered "I called a helpline or other support service" by the number of respondents who answered at least one of the following "I ignored it, I stood up to the bully or fought back, I tried talking to the bully, I told an adult at the school about it, I told my parents/guardians or another adult outside of school about it, I told another student about it, I called a helpline or other support service or I did something else" to the question: Think of the last time you were bullied. What did you do?

## Notes

This indicator is based on a survey question for students in New Brunswick's Anglophone schools. Survey results are only available for the Anglophone sector and Anglophone school districts. This indicator has replaced: SH\_BUYCH\_1.
