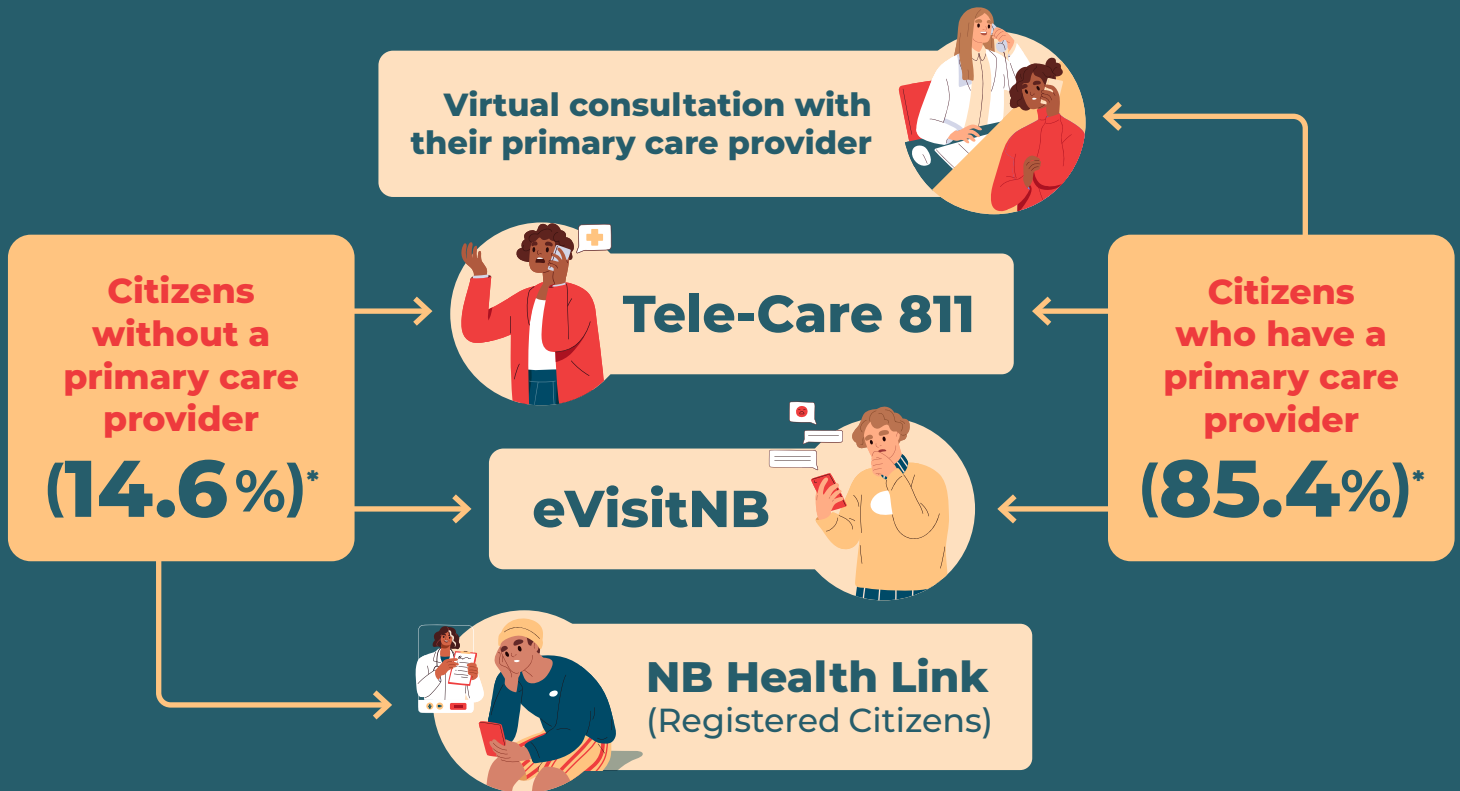


Access to Virtual Care Services in New Brunswick

NB Health Link

Designed to connect registered citizens without a family doctor or nurse practitioner to health care services until a permanent provider is available.

Medical appointments are available in-person, by telephone or online, depending on the symptoms and needs and can be provided in both official languages.

Virtual consultation with their primary care provider

Consultation with a citizen's personal family doctor or nurse practitioner that was not provided in-person.

Tele-Care 811

Bilingual and confidential, 24/7 health information and advice line for all New Brunswickers. Information is provided on health matters, including advice on the best ways to access services for specific needs.

eVisitNB

Virtual health care platform facilitating primary care delivery. These bilingual services are covered with a valid Medicare Card issued by the Government of New Brunswick.
