

AVOIDABLE DEATHS

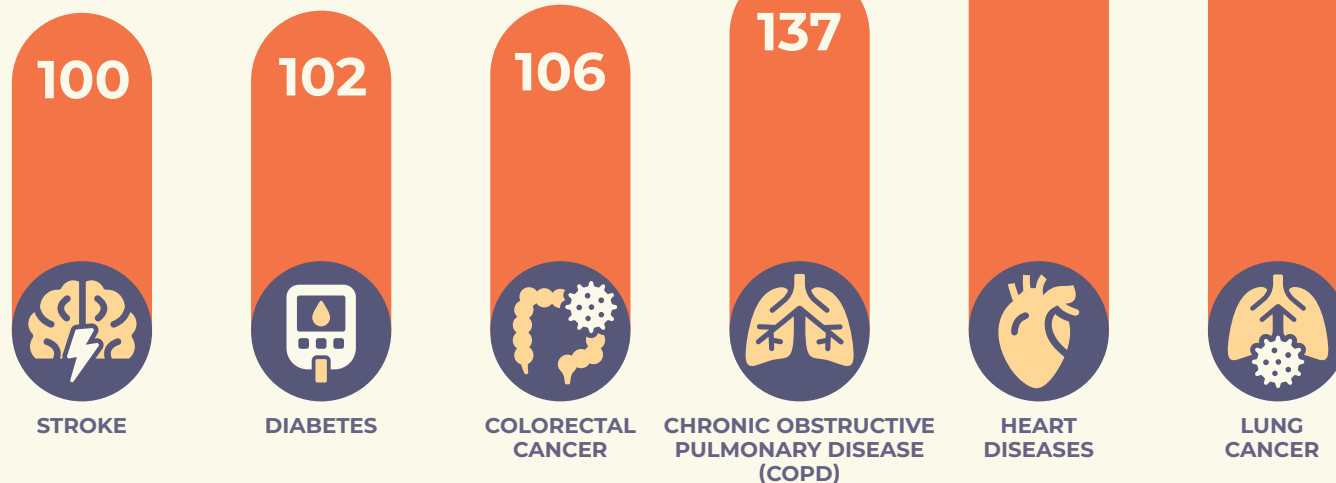
IN NEW BRUNSWICK

A key measure of our population's health, showing how prevention and quality care work together to save lives.



Every year, in New Brunswick from 2018 to 2022, about 2,000 New Brunswickers die from causes that could have been avoided. Six causes are behind **half** of these deaths.
