Key Focus Areas of Population Health



YOUR HEALTH

General health status, chronic health conditions, and quality of life.



HEALTH BEHAVIOURS

Nutrition, physical activity, substance use, and other lifestyle habits.



SCREENING & PREVENTION

Participation in health screenings, vaccinations, and preventive care.



HEALTH CARE SERVICES

Experience when using services and barriers to accessing care.



SOCIAL SUPPORT & COPING SKILLS

Social isolation, loneliness, and positive mental health.

Who uses the results and why?

- → Local leaders to identify key priorities for community health.
- → Health system leaders to make decisions about public health programs and resources.
- **→** Community organizations to create programs based on local needs.
